Dear Parents and Carers of New Year 7 Students

Google Chromebook Scheme

As we approach the end of what has been a very busy year at Queen Elizabeth's Grammar School, I would like to extend a very warm welcome to our new Year 7 students and parents in preparation for the new academic year in September.

To ensure a successful transition into the school, I am writing to you with details of our Google Chromebook Scheme, which I hope you are familiar with following previous communications from the school. What the scheme entails is the requirement for parents, where possible, to provide a Chromebook for their son or daughter to use at school. The school's commitment is to maintain the ICT infrastructure, including maintenance of the network and to provide the necessary technical support and resources to ensure the scheme runs successfully.

We would not wish any student to be excluded from the scheme on the grounds of cost and in cases of financial difficulty please contact Mr S Davison (Finance Manager) sid@queenelizabeths.kent.sch.uk, in confidence, as assistance may be available. For parents of students in receipt of the Pupil Premium, a significant financial contribution will be made to support the cost of the device. Please use this form to request information.

In return for an investment of £375 (paid in one full or five smaller amounts), students would be provided with a new Google Chromebook for use at home and at school, a protective carry case, $\mathbf{5}$ -year warranty, software and accidental damage insurance (limits apply), in addition to a Google Management and E-safety licence. After the 5 year period we can then offer chargeable in-house repairs at cost prices.

Alternatively, you have the option to use a **Chromebook device** that you already own, or source your device independently. If you choose to do this, we would require a payment of £48 to install a Google & E-safety licence, ensuring the device can be managed and kept up to date on our network. These licences are device specific and are non-transferable. Please use this $\underline{\text{form}}$ if you will be using your own device and only require the £48 licence.

We kindly request that you visit the **portal webpage** as soon as possible to order a device. We ask that orders are placed (through a direct debit or full payment) by **1pm on Monday 15th July 2024** to enable us to secure stock and configure the devices. We will arrange two collection dates in August, should your son or daughter wish to become familiar with the device before they start school. It is worth noting that whilst all devices are managed by the school, your son or daughter may also use their own personal Google login on the device outside of school hours, should you wish for them to do so.


