



HOME SCHOOL AGREEMENT

Success at school is best achieved by a partnership between parents, students and the school. To that end, members of the Queen Elizabeth's Grammar School Community are asked to agree the following.

Parents will:

- Encourage our child by taking an interest in their work. Make sure my child completes homework that appears in their 'to do' list on Google Classroom and in Guardian Summary emails.
- Ensure that my child goes to school and is on time; inform the school if my child is absent
- Make sure my child has the right equipment for school
- Send my child to school in full school uniform
- Encourage my child to behave well, and to support the school if sanctions become necessary
- Attend parents' meetings, read correspondence from school and reply if necessary
- Inform the school of any concerns or problems that might affect my child's work or attitude
- Take an interest in my child's life at school
- Ensure that my child will use the internet, in particular, social media, appropriately and safely

The School will:

- Provide a safe, secure environment in which your child is cared for and can be happy
- Provide lessons which enable your child to achieve high standards.
- Set, mark and monitor homework and provide both a student planner (year 7 student only) and access to subject based Google Classrooms
- Monitor attendance and contact parents if there is a problem
- Ensure that School uniform is worn appropriately
- Encourage high standards of behaviour and let parents know if there is a problem
- Encourage every student to achieve their full potential and to be a valued member of the community
- Encourage your child to become a self managing and responsible young person who achieves high standards of work and behaviour
- Mark and monitor work on a regular basis and check student planners regularly
- Keep parents informed about school matters and student progress
- Be welcoming and offer opportunities for parents to be involved in the broader elements of school life
- Provide regular safety education for students and parents, for example online safety, ensuring they are kept up to date

Students will:

- Concentrate and work hard in lessons, complete and submit homework on time and checking the work off on the Google Classroom 'to do' list as it is completed.
- Attend school every day, on time, and be punctual for all lessons
- Bring the right books and equipment to every lesson
- Wear uniform sensibly both in school and on the journey to and from school

- Behave well in lessons and at other times and accept necessary sanctions
- Follow the school rules
- Engage with class work and homework to the best of their ability
- Be polite and tolerant of others at all times
- Keep the school and its environment safe and free from litter and graffiti
- Use the internet and in particular, social media, appropriately and safely

The Student Charter
