












General Entry Requirements

A minimum of 33 points from your best 6 grades

A minimum choice of 3 subjects plus enhancement

A minimum of a Grade 4
in an English and
Mathematics - and one
of these must be a
Grade 5

If you would like to study 4 A Levels you need 45 points from your best 6 grades



Most subjects require a grade 6 in the relevant GCSE to study them at A Level, however there are some exceptions...

Mathematics and Further Mathematics

Grade 7 in GCSE Mathematics



Economics

Grade 6 in GCSE Economics

OR

Grade 6 in Mathematics & an average Grade 6 in English (Lang & Lit)

Film Studies

Grade 6 in Film Studies
OR

Grade 6 in English Language or Literature

Government & Politics

An average of grade 6 in English (Lang & Lit) and a grade 6 in a humanities subject



Physics

Grade 6 in Physics & Mathematics

Psychology

An average of a grade 6 in English (Lang & Lit), plus a grade 6 in both Biology & Mathematics

Sociology

An average of grade 6 in English (Lang & Lit) and a grade 6 in a humanities subject



Music

Grade 6 in GCSE Music and play an instrument or sing at Grade 5 or above

The Application Process

- Your deadline for submitting your application is the end of February 2025
 - Individual Application Meetings take place in March

- Kent Choices opens for applications after the October half term
- Your deadline for submitting your application is the end of May 2025
