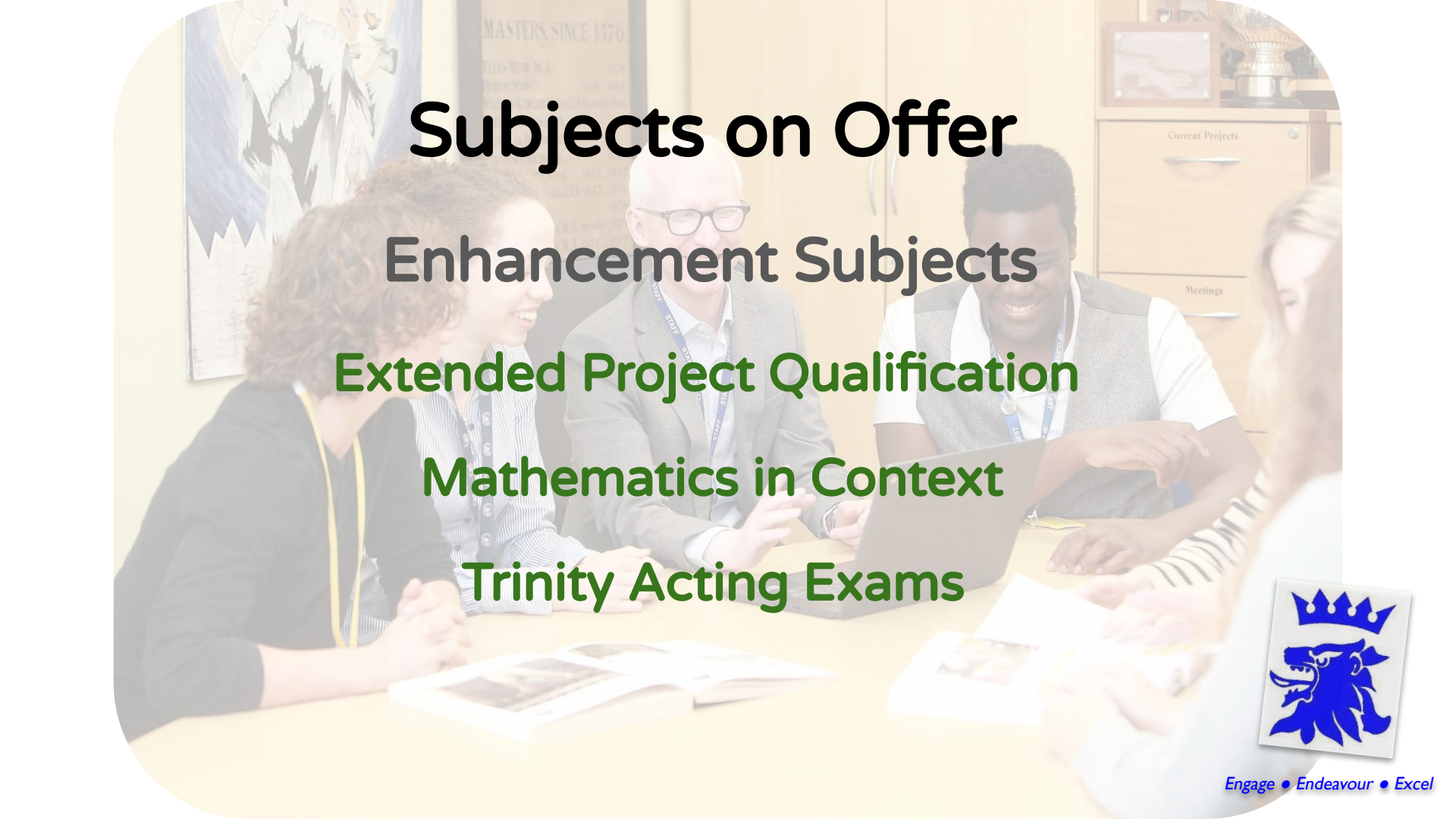

Subject Entry Requirements

Most subjects require a grade 6 in the relevant GCSE to study them at A Level, however there are some exceptions...

Grade 7 in GCSE Mathematics



Subject Entry Requirements

Economics

Grade 6 in GCSE Economics

OR

Grade 6 in Mathematics & an average Grade 6 in English (Lang & Lit)

Film Studies

Grade 6 in Film Studies

OR

Grade 6 in English Language or Literature

Government & Politics

An average of grade 6 in English (Lang & Lit) and a grade 6 in a humanities subject



Subject Entry Requirements

Physics

Grade 6 in Physics & Mathematics

Psychology

An average of a grade 6 in English (Lang & Lit), plus a grade 6 in both Biology & Mathematics

Sociology

An average of grade 6 in English (Lang & Lit) and a grade 6 in a humanities subject



Subject Entry Requirements

Music

Grade 6 in GCSE Music and play an instrument or sing at Grade 5 or above



The Application Process

Internals

- You will receive a link to a Google Form in November
- Your deadline for submitting your application is the end of February 2026
- Individual Application Meetings take place in March

Externals

- Kent Choices opens for applications after the October half term
- Your deadline for submitting your application is the end of May 2026
- If you receive an offer you need to respond to accept or decline
 - Virtual Application Events take place in March
