School Map

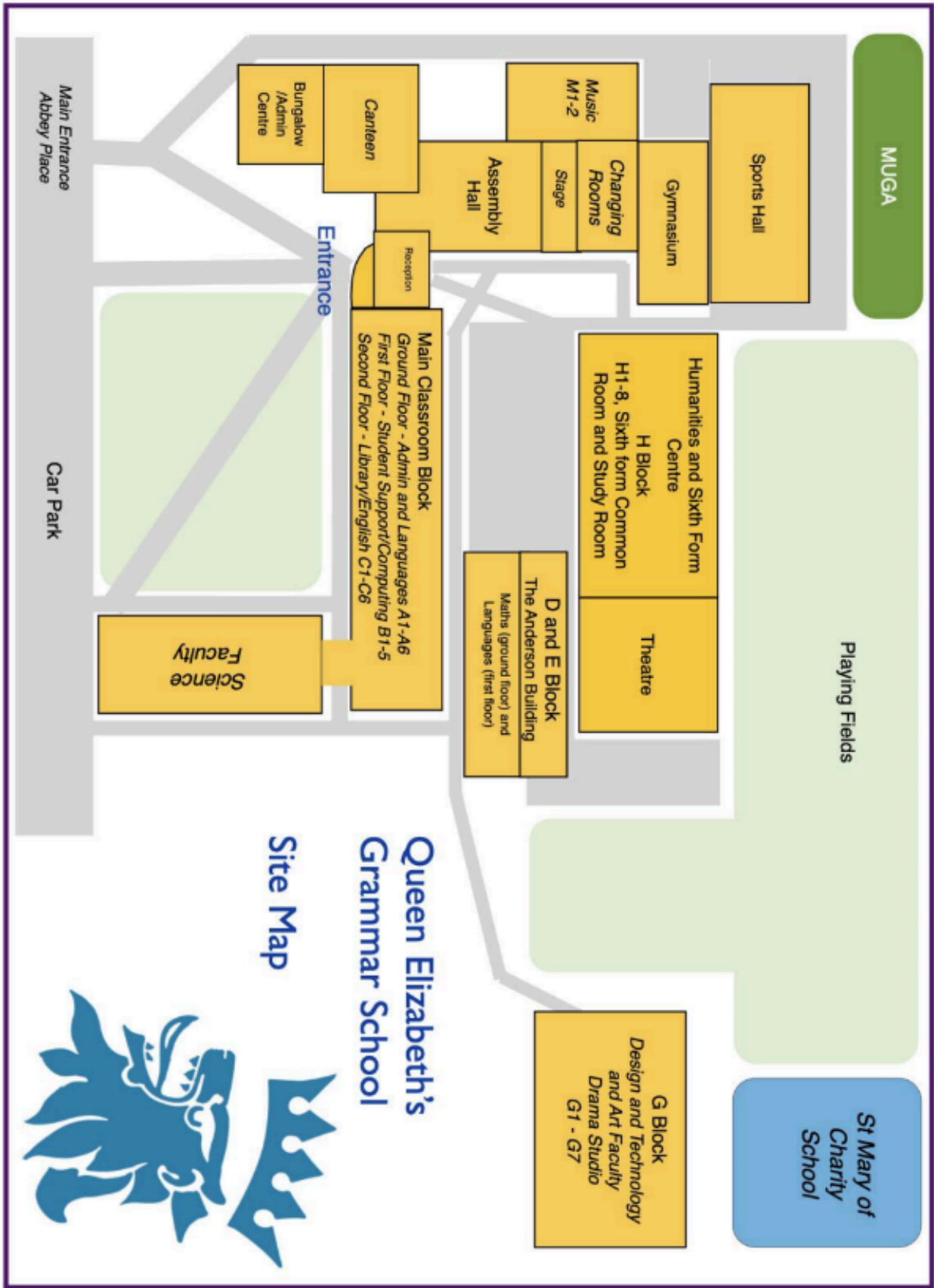

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Frequently Asked Questions

Can I park on site?	Unfortunately we have limited parking on site. Tesco Car Park has a 2 hour limit (1 hour for free and the second requires a minimum £5 purchase) and there is some street parking available around the school. For anyone who has specific access needs please contact us directly.
What should I expect from the Main Talk and the Subject Talks?	Main Talk - an introduction from senior staff to our school and what to expect from our Sixth Form. Subject Talks - everything you need to know about the subject! You will hear about the specification, style of learning and assessment criteria. You will meet the teachers that will be delivering the course.
Where do I go if I have questions?	There will be a refreshment area where current students can help you with answering questions. Our Sixth Form Team will also be available in the H Block.
How do I find my way around the school?	We will have some friendly student volunteers available to show you around if needed but we also have a map of the school on page 2.
Does the school have disability access?	Yes, the school is very accessible. If you require step-free access to the Music/Film Studies talks please let us know as soon as possible so we can assist you with this.
What happens next?	Students can apply to the Sixth Form via Kent Choices for external applicants and a Google Form for our internal applicants. We have a number of different activities in the pipeline to keep students and parents engaged so please keep an eye on your emails and our school website .
How many A Level choices should be in the application?	We recommend that students study 3 full A Levels and one enhancement subject (EPQ/Maths in Context/Acting exams). Some students may wish to study 4 full A Levels however please be aware that the entry requirements change in this situation. We also recommend that all students provide a reserve A Level choice to help us create better options for our timetable.
What is an enhancement subject?	It is an extra subject that can support your wider studies and acts like a "half A Level" in terms of time commitments. A lot of Universities and Higher Education providers look favourably on these subjects.
