We would like all students to produce a 1,000 word (approx) report on any news story/issue that occurs from 24th June-24th August that has relevance and a link to any part of the Year 12 A level specification.

The full specification can be reached using the link on the induction classroom (also below) but the broad topics are:

- 1. Tectonic Processes and Hazards**
- 2. Coastal Landscapes and Change**
- 3. Globalisation**
- 4. Regenerating Places**

The report needs to:

1. Outline the nature of the events that are occurring.
2. Identify a range of stakeholders involved, their role and position on the event/issue.
3. The future impacts of the issue/event.
4. An explanation of how this issue links directly to a specific numbered section(s) of the A Level specification.

We will expect the reports to be illustrated with photos, graphs, maps. This is not a copy and paste exercise, it should be clear that you have offered your own points of view and interpretation of the event.
