QEGS Students

- ❑ Applications will open, via Google Form, on November 2nd 2026
- ❑ You will have Taster Sessions for A Level subjects in February 2027
- ❑ Sixth Form Open Evening will take place on Thursday 4th February 2027
- ❑ Your deadline for completing your Sixth Form Application will be Friday 26th February 2027



QEGS Students

- ❑ You will have a Post-16 Application meeting at school in March 2027
 - ❑ You will discuss your first choice destination and why it is important to have a backup destination
 - ❑ You will explain why you have made the subject choices you have to check that they are suitable for your next steps in education and any future career plans you may have
 - ❑ You will learn more about why enhancement subjects are important and can boost your application to Higher Education and also link to vital job skills.



QEGS Students

- ❑ All QEGS students have a guaranteed, priority offer for Sixth Form
- ❑ If you meet the entry requirements for all of your subjects, your place will be confirmed
- ❑ If you miss one, or more, of the requirements you will need to make a decision on your next steps
 - ❑ This could be a change of subject choices, that you are qualified for...
 - ❑ ...or moving to a different school or college

External Applicants

- ❑ Applications will open, via Kent Choices, on November 2nd 2026
- ❑ Sixth Form Open Evening will take place on Thursday 4th February 2027
- ❑ Your deadline for completing your Sixth Form Application will be Friday 26th February 2027
- ❑ After the deadline has passed, all applications will be considered and successful candidates will receive a Conditional Offer



External Applicants

- ❑ Applicants that have received a Conditional Offer will be invited to attend a compulsory Online Application Meeting in March. This meeting will explain the next steps in the application process
- ❑ If you do not attend the Online Application Meeting, your Conditional Offer will be withdrawn
- ❑ You can 'Accept' your offer via Kent Choices
- ❑ You can rank your applications according to your preferences



Sixth Form Induction

- Our Induction event takes place over two days at the end of June/beginning of July
- Invitations to the event will be prioritised as follows
 - a. Internal students, and external applicants that have ranked QEGS as their number 1 preference
 - b. External applicants that have ranked QEGS as their number 2 preference
 - c. External applicants that have ranked QEGS as their number 3 preference or lower
- When the maximum number of places available has been met, applicants that still wish to attend will be placed on a waiting list



GCSE Results Day - QEGS Students

- ❑ Your results are emailed to you along with a letter from the Headteacher explaining your next steps...
 - ❑ A letter - Your place in Sixth Form, with your chosen subjects, is confirmed.
 - ❑ B letter - Your place in Sixth Form is confirmed, however you may need to change one or more of your subject choices*
 - ❑ C letter - You have missed the required grades for a place in Sixth Form and will need to look at different schools or colleges*
 - ❑ *options B and C can be dependent on exam mark appeals
- ❑ You will complete a Google Form on the same day to confirm your place

GCSE Results Day - External Students

- ❑ You email your results to us and we do the following
 - ❑ Check that you have met the requirements or not
 - ❑ If yes, provisionally allocate you a place in our Sixth Form
 - ❑ Verify that you have completed the online application form
 - ❑ Check that spaces are available in your chosen subjects
 - ❑ Email you to confirm the above and send you a link to a Google Form
- ❑ You will complete the Google Form by the deadline to confirm you would like to accept your place in our Sixth Form (if the Sixth Form is oversubscribed at this point, the offer will still be conditional. More details on the next page)



GCSE Results Day - External Students

- ❑ Our Pupil Admission Number (PAN) will identify how many spaces are available in the Sixth Form. In the event of there being more students completing the Google Form than there are spaces available, all external applicants will be ranked according to our Oversubscription Criteria. In priority order, the criteria will be:

- ❑ Looked After Children
- ❑ Free School Meals or Pupil Premium
- ❑ Sibling association
- ❑ Children of staff
- ❑ Medical, health, social and special access
- ❑ Nearness of home (postcode)
